Re-registration of your membership with South Melbourne LSC

1. Log on to the SLSA website: www.slsa.com.au
2. Go to Lifesaving Online [top right hand area of web page]

4. Once you have received your registration confirmation from SLSA, you can login to your membership details and make changes as required.

3. Working With Children Checks (WWCC)

Any adult (18yr+) within the Club must have a Working With Children Check. South Melbourne Life Saving Club is required to comply with the "Working With Children Act 2005" (the Act) and there are no exemptions. The required form is available from all Australia Post outlets.

To assist with this compliance and for convenience to members an *Australia Post* employee will be at the clubhouse on **SATURDAY 12th SEPTEMBER** to process forms, id & photos.

To avoid waiting and cue times, could you please have your form filled out prior to arrival as well as having your passport photo at hand (we will have a limited resource to take some photos on the day if supplied ones aren't satisfactory).

Please bring 3 types of proof of identity, as stated on page 9 of the application guide and form.

We appreciate your help with this matter and trust the opportunity to submit your form at the club on this date will ease the process for all concerned.
